### Canteen committee

For the past 2 years Donita Kerrin has been co-ordinating the management of the canteen. Donita has informed me that for various reasons she has decided to step down from this voluntary position. I know you join me in thanking Donita for her commitment to this role and all it entails. She will stay on until a replacement is found. Catherine Strbik has joined Donita this term, taking on some of the tasks with stocktake and ordering.

The issue of the co-ordination of the canteen was discussed at the P&F meeting last week. A decision was made to form a committee, possibly 3 people sharing the tasks and decisions. If you would like to join this committee please apply via me by Friday 6th April. The tasks can take anything from 30 minutes to 1-2 hours a week of your time depending on the tasks. Some tasks can be done from home online. There will be people to show you the ropes. The P&F exec and I will appoint a committee after 6th April.

### Kiss N Drop zone - new access to church driveway before school

The new zone has been back in action this week and is being utilised by at least 15-25 students per day. It will continue **if we get volunteers** (parents, grandparents or parishioners are very welcome) to supervise. At the moment we only have volunteers for Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. **We need people for Thursday and Friday otherwise it can't operate on those days.**

Ultimately 2 people rostered per day would work so that it can be shared. Please contact Kerrie at the office with your name and number and preferred day. A reminder if you choose to use the driveway as drop off, the rules are:

- 8.30-9.00 am- Kiss n Drop zone only - DO NOT PARK in the church driveway
- One way set up. Enter from Waterloo St, stay in your car, **drop off when you are at the front of the line** and exit via Lagoon St.
- Students walk along the pavement and into the school gate.

Please be aware the council ranger has been in the area in the last 2 weeks, monitoring the drop off and pick up zones and the bus zone in Lagoon St. Please adhere to the road rules for the safety of our children

### St Joseph's Day Feast and Beach Afternoon

On Monday afternoon the whole school gathered in the church for a liturgy to celebrate the feast day of St Joseph, our patron saint. The year 6 students opened with a beautiful song about community, accompanied by a movie of our students in class and the playground that really captured the spirit of community here at St Joseph's.

To assist families keep up to date with payment of school fees, the current instalment dates for Term 1 are:


- Standard Instalments: Payment was due **23 February**, next payment **4 May**.
