## Chill Out Zone

To strengthen our Friendology Program we have purchased some new resources to create a Chill Out Zone on the playground near the sports shed. This is an area to be used by students who need a break from the fast pace of the playground, to regulate emotions or to find a friend to play a quiet game together. We have purchased colourful matting, sensory toys, dress ups, car play mats, a bubble machine, colouring, chalk, balance boards and more. We also have a mini tramp that will be introduced for those students who need time away from games to calm and reset, but still be on the move.


