#### **Parent Information Evening**

This will be held on Monday Feb 17th. There are two identical sessions - one at 6.30pm and one at 7.00pm. The sessions are half hour and repeated so that you can get to at least two classes if you have more than one child at the school. This is a great chance to hear the focus of your child's learning and find out how you can best support them. Parents will hear from their child's teacher, in their child's classroom. (This is for parents only, no students).

We'll cover off the events planned for the year and allocate these to classes, so all class parents for 2025 will hopefully be able to attend (or at least one of you). ### **Lunch at the Beach!**

We're thrilled to launch a new initiative this term. Years 3-6 will take turns to go across to the beach area at selected lunch times, for beach breaks. (Our Kindy, 1 and 2 classes will visit the beach during class time). This will expand our play area and make the most of our gorgeous environment. We're trialling this during Term 1 and hope to keep it going! You don't need to bring anything extra (thongs, equipment) but it's a great reminder to always apply sunscreen before school and pack a hat.

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# Good to Know



#### **Safety Reminders - Play Equipment**

We don't want to be the playground grinch, but as our playground is on school grounds, we need teacher supervision when children are playing on it. That means we need to respectfully ask you don't let younger siblings play on the equipment before or after school. Thanks for your understanding.

#### **Kiss n Ride Etiquette**

We'd like to gently remind you of some Kiss n Ride tips, with the focus always being on **safety first.** We only have three spots and want to ensure the process is as smooth as possible for everyone. We also have lots of new people adjusting to how it works so thank you for your support and patience. The rules that govern the use of Kiss n Ride zones are set by law, not us. Please adhere to the law so that all students are safe.

- Please never park in Kiss n Ride to walk your Joey in. If they're unexpectedly distressed, please pop them safely back in your vehicle, park in a suitable spot and walk in.
- Please only exit the vehicle if you have to (IE to help your child safely load or unload.). If you need to leave your car, please stay within 5m of the car and keep things as quick as safely possible.
- There is no teacher to assist in the morning. Our teachers will bring your child to your vehicle in the afternoon, and it helps if you have your name displayed in the window. (If you need a sign, you can ask Kerrie in the office.)
- Please only use one of the spots available. If you don't fit in the allocated spot, do a lap of the block. Don't queue in Wellington Street. There's also a No Stopping area just in front of the Kiss n Ride zone and last year, rangers booked several parents, so please be aware and careful not to go too far forward.
- It helps to remember that Kiss n Ride clears REALLY quickly outside of peak times. In the afternoon, it's very busy between 3pm and 3.10 and completely empty by 3.11pm! Try arriving a few mins after 3.05pm to stagger traffic.
- Please don't honk or shout at other parents. It will only upset everyone and respect is a key value of our community.
- Don't swoop in to an empty spot in front if one pops up and you're driving past. We have seen some nasty accidents happen this way, as the 'behind' vehicle may be moving up into the gap or also exiting. Just take the extra minute to do a lap.
- If it's really busy, and you can, try parking nearby and walking up it can often be even quicker.
- Do not execute a U-turn in Lagoon St in front of the school it is illegal.


