Key Info

NAPLAN: Yrs 3 & 5

NAPLAN stands for the National Assessment of Literacy and Numeracy skills, and is relevant for all students in Years 3, 5, 7, 9.

It begins with a writing assessment on Wednesday March 12th. Then there is an assessment each day until Friday 14th March.

We also allow make up days for students who are away ill on the days of assessments, Monday 17th and Tuesday 18th March.

Students will participate in tests for writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy.

NAPLAN is just one part of our school's learning assessment program. The tests assess literacy and numeracy skills your child is already learning at school, so the best preparation is their everyday classroom learning.

Our school will also undertake activities to help students become familiar with the types of questions and tools available in the online tests. The <u>public demonstration site</u> is available for you to see the format of the online tests. Further information about NAPLAN is available on the <u>NESA website</u> and the <u>NAP website</u>.
