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RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

MATHEMATICS

. In mathematics K-2, students:

- develop essential numeracy skills and mathematical fluency
- identify, describe and apply patterns and relationships
- develop their reasoning and problem-solving skills
- apply their knowledge and understanding in practical situations and make informed decisions.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Move it!

Our Science and Technology unit, titled 'Move it!' Asks students to explore our world and how everything in it is constantly changing and moving. They will investigate concepts of movement and change through exploring toys and objects.

Students will be exploring how we are similar and different, how we can care about and include one another, as well as how to stay healthy and safe.

ENGLISH

The content is structured and sequenced to highlight the connections across *oral language*, *reading fluency*, *comprehension*, *and writing* and underpinned by the latest international research of phonics and phonemic awareness.

GEOGRAPHY

People Live in Places, My Community

Students explore the places they live in and belong to. They develop an understanding of what makes a place special and how this may differ for different people.

HOMEWORK

Homework will be given to the children weekly in their Homework folders. Their homework folders will be sent home on their Talk time day and is to be returned on this day the following week.

CREATIVE ARTS

Kindergarten are exploring Visual Arts through exploring how to create selfportraits through drawing and painting in a unit titled 'All about me'. Music, Dance and Drama will be explored through specialist music

lessons with Mr Warby and through integration into daily topics where students will express themselves through movement and role-playing.
